Conservation / Prevention of Medical Plants and its Awareness

Taking the perspective of providing awareness about Ayurvedic Medicinal Plants to the next generation and also in order to aware the values of these medicinal plants and its conservation / prevention for future, Susrutha Charitable Medical Trust initiated an action-plan named "Puthiyathalamurakku Oru Oushadhathottam" (Ayurveda Garden for the new Generation). The program was planned to be organized with schools in the district. Procedure as to how to sow the seeds and nourish these plants will be explained to the participants of the programme.

On 21st December 2018, Shri. K. Ramachandran, Honorable President, Poovachal Panchayath, inaugurated the program at Government L.P.S. Kattakkada. The inaugural speech was provided by Shri. R. Raghavalal, P.T.A. President and succeeded with the Keynote speech by Dr. K. Krishna Kumar, Secretary, Susrutha Charitable Medical Trust. He also provided an awareness session to the students detailing how the medicinal plants could be used in their day-to-day living.

Due to the unprecedented rains, the water level in most of the 54 dams all over Kerala raised above the danger level and the authorities were forced to open the shutters of 35 dam, which took the life of almost 400 individuals and around 14,50,707 persons had to live in several relief camp organized by state government.

Susrutha Charitable Medical Trust drafted and action plan in order to help the needy persons who are staying in different relief camps. On 17th September, 2018, in order to provide the basic things needed, the trust started to serve in the relief camps by providing kits.
